


The 1960-61 Varsity Football season was a very good one, considering they were under a new head coach. The coach I am talking about is Mr. John Lowry, the record was 3-6.



















### AZTECS OF THE WEEK

The honor of man of the week goes to the player who was considered outstanding by the coaches. As a reward for this honor they are awarded a shirt by the Man's Shop.








